INSULATION 101

EPDM, TPO & PVC 101

This webinar will also feature newer topic of discussion: resilience. Completion of the 101- to 301-level classes is recommended.

UNDERSTANDING DESIGN CRITERIA 401

This advanced class teaches attendees how to apply the performance section of an architectural specification to a warrantable roof assembly. Utilizing web-based tools, attendees will learn how to determine whether a proposed system can meet specific design requirements. System examples will be used to enhance learning through classroom tutorials and testing demonstrations. As a prerequisite to this course, attendees should have advanced knowledge of Carlisle's roofing systems, applications, and warranties. Completion of the 101- to 301-level classes is recommended.

INDUSTRY CHALLENGES 501

This advanced class will examine common industry challenges, including the differences in versions of industry standards (ASCE, IBC, IECC, etc.), moisture in concrete, reflectivity, LEED, ES-1, and energy codes. At the end of this class, attendees will have a strong understanding of industry standards and building design science as it relates to single-ply roofing. As a prerequisite to this course, attendees should have advanced knowledge of Carlisle's roofing systems, products, and applications, as well as a basic understanding of design aspects. Completion of the 101- to 401-level classes is recommended.
